Prescott Valley man arrested on two year old burglary

On February 22, 2007 Prescott Valley Police Officers investigated a burglary at the Open Door Baptist Church on Stevens drive. Unknown suspects entered the church and broke a glass door and other items inside the church. They also wrote profanities on a wall and a dry erase board inside the building. Officers collected physical evidence, but had no leads at the time.

Recently Prescott Valley Police Detectives received information on a fingerprint hit from the state. One of the fingerprints located at the scene came back to a Nathan Shepherd of Prescott Valley. Shepherd is now 18 years of age.

Shepherd was interviewed at the Prescott Valley Police Department by detectives and he admitted involvement in the offense.

Investigators believe that other suspects were involved with Shepherd in this case.

Shepherd was booked into the Yavapai County Jail for aggravated criminal damage and burglary.
