Prescott Valley man arrested for stalking

On January 10th, 2010 at approximately 11:57 A.M. Richard Ray McBride was arrested in Prescott as a result of a Prescott Valley stalking investigation.

The Prescott Valley Police Department investigated allegations that a Prescott resident, identified as 50 year old Richard Ray McBride, had been harassing/stalking his adult ex-girlfriend. McBride was reported to have followed the victim, called her repeatedly and made other attempts to contact her at her residence. He had been served an order of protection to leave the victim alone several months ago, but the behavior persisted.

On January 10th the victim called the Prescott Valley Police and said that McBride was outside her residence again. Officers responded and McBride had already fled the area. An attempt to locate request was sent to Prescott Police as McBride lives in the Prescott area.

Officers learned that Prescott Police located McBride and detained him. During their contact with McBride, Prescott Police discovered that McBride was displaying fictitious plates that had been altered on his vehicle. McBride was also driving on a suspended license.

Prescott Valley Police personnel responded and interviewed McBride at the Prescott Police Department. McBride made some incriminating statements about his involvement in the offense. He further admitted to smoking marijuana recently.

McBride was booked into the Yavapai County Jail in Camp Verde for the following charges by both Prescott Valley and Prescott Police Departments.

Prescott Valley Police: Stalking and Violation of a court order

Prescott Police: Aggravated DUI, possession/use of marijuana, driving on a suspended license and displaying fictitious plates

McBride may also face charges for aggravated harassment on an earlier police report.
