Overdose leads to two arrests

On December 18th at approximately 5:50 P.M. Prescott Valley Police Officers responded to an apartment in the 3200 block of Tani Road for a possible heroin overdose.

Officers learned that a 25 year old female Prescott Valley resident had possibly overdosed on heroin. She was reported to have injected heroin into her system earlier in the evening.

She was transported to the Yavapai Regional Medical Center for medical treatment.

Officers obtained consent to search the residence. During the search Officers found both heroin and methamphetamines in the apartment.

Both residents, 31 year old John Jakobson and 21 year old Caitlin Carole McGee, were arrested for possession of a narcotic drug, possession of dangerous drugs and possession of drug paraphernalia and booked into the Yavapai County Jail in Camp Verde.

The condition of the female overdose victim is not known at this time.

It is important to respect the lethal potential of heroin. It is a highly addictive drug with a great potential for overdose and death. Heroin and other drugs can be manufactured with different potencies and the user may overdose accidentally. It is important to talk to your children or friends about using drugs and educate them about the dangers involved.
